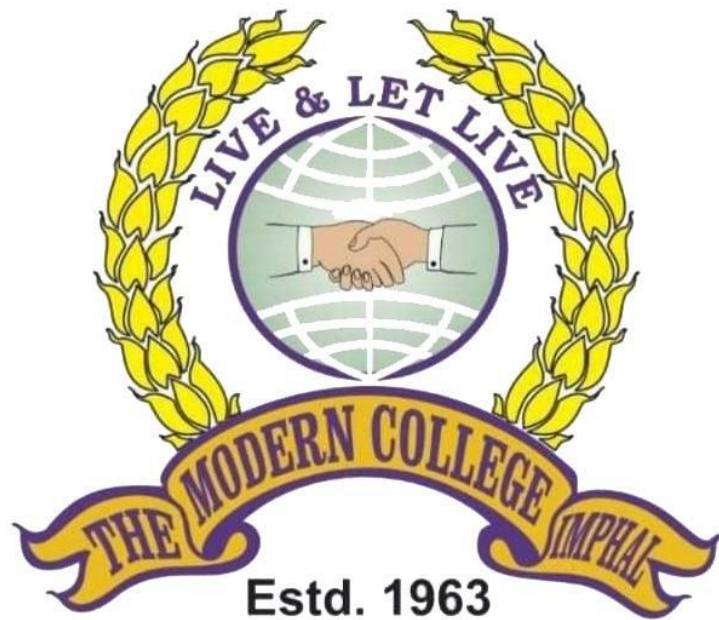

In addition to semester examination conducted by Manipur University the college has been conducting internal assessment for improvement in the teaching learning process. Semesterwise preparatory evaluation Unit tests are held under IQAC directive, though not counted for university evaluation. However, it has been immensely useful for both students and teachers in the teaching learning process. Compulsorily home assignments for their extensive studies are given time to time. The department also conducts classroom seminars for 6th Semester students based on syllabus. Conductor seminar benefit knowledge enhancement and personality development for the students. Tutorial classes are arranged mainly for weaker students. That is how, Students and teachers transact interaction throughout the academic session.

Infrastructure

Despite of better desired facilities the department attempts to maintain the available resources effectively. The department has six faculty members having long experience in teaching viable to upgrade into Postgraduate degree. The department also have opportunity to have maximum student enrolment. The political science department has a separate staff room measuring 25*30 ft. sq. equipped with required facilities such as chairs, tables, noticed board, interactive board, book shelve and almirah etc. The department also maintains its departmental library with textbooks, reference body, and journals to facilities the students' needs.

Activities:

The faculty member consists of different communities viz. Meitei, Pangal and Tribals from different religious background. The beauty of the Department of Political Science lies in its diversity.

The department strictly follows the academic calendar to cope with academic activities for teaching-learning process. The teachers carry out the classroom lectures where interaction between the teachers and students take place. In addition to the offline classes, the department also conducted online classes as normal classes are disrupted by the pandemic. Indeed, the teacher-student have keen interest in e-learning. The semester wise Whatsapp group is also created for information and discussions on syllabus related topics. Apart from holding classes both teachers and students compulsorily involve in the curricular activities for Inter-House competitions in literary, cultural games and sports. Teachers are also in charge of various of various committees constituted by the college for which they sincerely render services. Mention be made that the department of political science is the nodal agency for Human Rights Education Cell of the college in connection with the IQAC. The

department organizes and observes, the international U.N. Human Rights Day on 10th December every year.
