PROSE & POETRY

Course outcome

POETRY (Zaila) : 30 Marks

After completion of this unit, the students will learn and understand -

- The exclusive message of the poem and the folklore associated with it.
- To appreciate the traditional and cultural aspects of the poem.
- To capture the central idea of the poem.
- To read the poem with correct rhyme and rhythm.

PROSE (Thimthu) : 40 Marks

After completion of this unit, the students will learn and understand -

- Narration in prose closely follows the general patterns found in day-to-day conversation, with certain structural devices marking the art form status of the pieces narrated.
- The basic purpose here is to convey an idea, deliver information, or tell a story.

GRAMMAR & COMPOSITION (Pao juidih le Thusem bu) : 30 Marks

After completion of this unit, the students will learn and understand -

- The purpose, apart of implementing the government's policy, is to bring education to the students in their own language (mother tongue) which is of great necessity.
- Language is often shaped by the culture of the particular group who speak it. Therefore, the student will learn language acquisition, phrases, idioms and unique cultural concepts apart from grammar and composition.

DRAMA & SHORT STORIES

Course outcome

DRAMA (Limtho) : 40 Marks

After completion of this unit, the students will learn and understand -

- The plays here introduce audiences to characters, settings, history, folktales and situations they might not encounter in their everyday lives; or, if they do encounter them, plays may inspire new ways of thinking about these subjects.
- It tells stories without the exposition of novels and other literary forms, and this allows the audience to connect directly with what the characters say and how they behave on stage.
- To bring the spirit of Unity and Integrity in a multi-cultural state like ours.
- To bring the spirit of patriotism in the hearts of the students.

SHORT STORIES : 60 Marks

After completion of this unit, the students will learn and understand -

- The aim is to give the student the wisdom to understand life from different points of view through the use of stories, writings (prose), humour, cultural folktales, etc.
- They employ folklores/folktales which are used to pass down a culture's morals and values from one generation to the next all the while entertaining the reader.
